Because the original poop bags did not degrade sufficiently, the city has ordered new bags for testing. They will be at the park as soon as they have been received and new dispensers are installed.

Next spring the city will build a storage shed for agility equipment. We will ask the National Guard about building the entry structure and the Eagle Scouts about building shelters in each of the 3 yards.
